The sun will be hot, you perspire heavily, all noise level gets higher and higher and you regret why you are here.]

If you are planning on a longer stay, you can purchase a Florence pass and it can get you in a lot of exhibitions. But it only last 3 days and the new price is 72Euros. The big thing is to wait in line. Everywhere you go, you will have to wait. So be prepared for it.
