Professor James Tong Scholarship for Resilience

Background

1. Wah Yan College, Kowloon is a Jesuit school and our Jesuit education aims to nurture Men of Human Excellence, our students being groomed to embody attributes of competence, commitment, compassion and conscience. They grow up to be “Men for and with Others” and aspire to be leaders-in-service.
2. We serve the faith that does justice and we embrace students who come from underprivileged families. Students have equal opportunities to receive quality education, and this Scholarship aims to award students who show resilience in adversity and display satisfactory academic and non-academic performance despite family financial hardship due to the pandemic.

Eligibility

3. The Scholarship is open to financially needy students from S.1 to S.6. The eligible applicants are supported by either the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) Scheme or other subsidies such as the textbook allowance or any waiver to sustain their studies.

Selection Criteria

4. We look for students who show resilience in adversity and display satisfactory academic and non-academic performance. Students' performance in the interview would also be considered.

Award Details

5. This is a one-off scholarship for the academic school year of 2020-2021. The awarded student will receive the Scholarship of HKD10,000.

Selection and Announcement of Results

6. Financially needy students who show resilience in adversity and display satisfactory academic and non-academic performance will be shortlisted for the scholarship. The school will review their information and also consider their performance in the interview.
7. The awardees of the Scholarship will be notified of the result individually.
