

Sogang University

Established in 1960, Sogang University has 8100 undergraduate students and 4000 graduate students, with 7 schools and 24 departments




Microcosm of global society

Development timeline

- 1960 Sogang College began as a liberal arts college with six departments-English Language and Literature, History, Philosophy, Mathematics, Physics, Economics
- 1968 The Graduate school was opened with Masters' program
- 1970 University Charter was granted by the Ministry of Education
- 1976 Research Institute for Communications was established
- 1977 Advanced Institute of Accounting was established
- 1981 Research Institute for English as an International Language was established
- 1984 Technology Management Institute was established

1988 - College of Social Science and Law Department were opened

1988 - Research Institute for Philosophy was established

1988 – 1999 Opened 7 Graduate Schools in 11 years

- 1988 Graduate School of Public Policy was opened with three departments
- 1990 Graduate School of Education was opened with ten majors
- 1991 Graduate School of Economics was opened with six departments
- 1992 Graduate School of Mass Communication was opened with four majors
- 1997 Graduate School of International Studies was opened
- 1997 Graduate School of Information and Technology was opened
- 1999 Graduate School of Media Communications was opened
