Visit to HK Police Explosive Ordnance Disposal Bureau



On 15 March 2014 (Saturday), WYKPSA has organized a visit and career talk at Hong Kong Police Explosive Ordnance Disposal Bureau (爆炸品處理課). Participants were given the rare opportunity to visit the highly guarded restricted area at Mount Butler, which is located above all buildings in Tai Hang. During the 3-hour visit, Hong Kong Police has shown to us some rendered safe unexploded ordnance from World War II, the sophisticated bomb disposal robots and other equipment. Some of the participants also tried to wear the bomb disposal protective coat, which is over 60 pounds in weight. No photo was allowed in the depot and only photos were allowed at the entrance! So only the participants know how amazing was the visit!
