Keynote Speakers (draft bio)

Mr Chris Lowney is the author of four books. *Heroic Leadership: Best Practices from a 450-year-old company that changed the world*, a # 1 ranked bestseller of the CBPA, was named a finalist for a 2003 Book of the Year Award from ForeWord magazine and has been translated into eleven languages. He is also author of *Heroic Living*, and *A Vanished World*. His latest work, *Pope Francis: Why He Leads the Way He Leads*, has been called, “an invaluable gift,” and “a book for the ages.”

He is a one-time Jesuit seminarian who later served as a Managing Director of J.P. Morgan & Co in New York, Tokyo, Singapore and London until leaving the firm in 2001. He is a popular keynote speaker who has lectured in more than two-dozen countries on leadership, business ethics, decision-making and other topics. He now chairs the board of Catholic Health Initiatives, one of the largest healthcare/hospital systems in the US with some \$ 19 billion in assets.

Fr Jose Mesa, S.J. is currently the Secretary for Secondary and Pre-secondary Education for the Society of Jesus in the world. As such he is responsible for the coordination of the Jesuit School World Network. He is a visiting professor on the Cultural and Educational Policy Studies program. He earned a Ph.D. in Philosophy and Education from Teachers College-Columbia University, New York, with a focus on Moral Education. He also holds a Master of Education with Concentration in Human Development and Psychology from Harvard University. He has worked for many years in different high schools in his home country, Colombia, and was responsible for the construction of the first, in process, LEED certified school in Latin America. His research interests are primarily Moral Education, Citizenship Education, and Ignatian Pedagogy.
